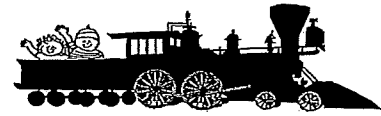

News from the Clinic

June is finally here. Hopefully, all the rain we have had will wash away the pollen and we can say good bye to the allergies that have plagued us recently. As we look forward to the event packed month, just a few reminders for our many field trips that are planned.

*Please dress your student for the weather. We may feel it is summer, but June can still have a few cool days. With that said, please dress your child in layers, like a short sleeved top with a sweatshirt. It is better to be able to take a layer off than to be cold all day. If it is raining, please send your student with appropriate rain gear for the field trip

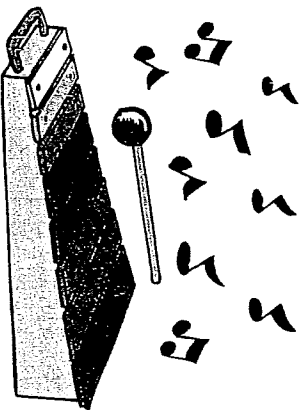
* Comfortable walking shoes are appropriate for all field trips. No flip flops please.

* Please send a water bottle with your student to school. Warmer weather increases the chance of dehydration.

*Please apply sunscreen to your student before sending them to school. Even on a cloudy day they could get sunburn. The American Cancer Society recommends a minimum of SPF 30 to protect against UVA and UVB radiation. The school nurse is not allowed to apply sunscreen at school.
