

Parent Reminders for the School Year

Students entering 7th grade require a Tdap and 2nd Varicella Vaccine

Medications, especially Epi-Pens and Inhalers should be delivered to the school nurse with physician's order and parent consent on DAY 1 of school. Forms are located on the School Health Services webpage.

Please report to the school nurse any important medical information or concerns regarding your student.

New students entering the district schools at any grade level must have an up to date immunization record consistent with state mandated requirements from the MA Dept of Public Health and a copy of a current physical exam.

Prescription Medications Requirements

- *Signed physician order
- *Signed parent consent
- *Current pharmacy labeled bottle matching the physician's order
- *Delivered to school nurse only by parent or guardian on DAY ONE of School

Please return the emergency card and notify the nurse of any changes during the school year.

Student athletes must have a current, annual physical on file in order to participate in practice and school sports.

Students with diabetes need to have orders and diabetic supplies brought to the health office on DAY ONE: insulin, snacks, glucose and ketone testing supplies, glucagon etc

Please call the attendance line when your child will not be in school.

Please send in a copy of a new physical exam or when your child receives an immunization from their health care provider. It is important to keep the health record current and accurate to follow Massachusetts immunization and physical exam compliance.
