

Parent / Student Guidelines for DY's online learning plan

This plan will be in place beginning Monday, March 30th

- Students should continue to turn in missing assignments, we have asked teachers to extend deadlines to help students that did not turn in assignments previously issued during term 3.
- Each time a class “meets,” teachers will provide an assignment or task to complete.
 - Assignments will be very manageable for students and students should submit the assignments for credit when completed.
 - Assignments should be set up so students can do the work at any time, not necessarily when the class is scheduled to “meet”
- Teachers will be available for a discussion through email or google classroom during “class time”
- Teachers will provide feedback to students on any and all assignments thru email or google classroom.
- Students should receive credit for work that is completed.

- Special education teachers will become part of each of their students content teachers google classroom and be checking in with their students to provide support, that will help their students complete any and all online assignments.
