Parent / Student Update On DYRHS Remote Learning Plan

Please remember that the situation that we are in is constantly changing and DY will change and adapt to give our students the best opportunity to improve academically.

Student Expectations

- DY's Remote learning schedule was developed to give both students and teachers a direction to follow throughout this pandemic.
- The primary means of instruction will be done using Google Classroom.
- We are asking teachers to provide small manageable assignments for students to complete.
- We are expecting our teachers to be available by email during their scheduled class time. Example if a student has Biology A Block his or her teacher should be available by email during that block to help students navigate the assignment.
- We would like students to try and follow their class schedule and log into their specific class using google classroom at the designated time.
- However we know that during this remote learning time students may not be available during the scheduled time or the technology they are using is not available at that time. We know that in many homes there are more than one sibling using a limited amount of technology and this can make specific times difficult to adhere to.
- If students cannot log in to Google Classroom during their designated class time then they should log in when they have a chance.
- Students and Parents should feel free to email their teacher and assistant principal with any academic questions.
- We would hope students would make every effort to try and complete the assignments posted by our teachers.
- I have asked all teachers to extend deadlines on previous assignments to give students an opportunity to make up any work for term 3.
- Teachers will be available for a discussion through email or google classroom during "class time"
- Teachers will provide feedback to students on any and all assignments thru email or google classroom.
- Based on the Department of Education Guidelines, students should receive credit for work that is completed.
