DYRHS Remote Learning Plan Term 4 Modification

Please remember that the situation that we are in is constantly changing and DY will change and adapt to give our students the best opportunity to improve academically.

Dennis-Yarmouth Regional High School Faculty and Staff understand the incredible impact this pandemic has had on our community. We are concerned with everyone's health and well-being. Any disruption in the learning process can cause emotional issues among both students and faculty. We would like everyone to know that our students, parents, and faculty's emotional well-being is also crucial to us. In addition we are concerned that all of our students and families have equitable resources during this very difficult time. Over the last couple of weeks the DYRHS Administration Leadership Team has developed a plan for Term 4. The Plan was designed to be extremely equitable for all our students.

DYRHS Term 4 Grading Procedures for Grades 8 - 11

- Term 4 will run May 4, 2020-June 19, 2020
- Term 4 will be graded as Credit/No credit:
- For a student to receive Credit for a Term 4 class they must:
 - \circ Complete 70% of the work for classes
 - Complete 80% of the work for honors classes
 - Credit is based on work completion, not based on grading
- If a student receives credit, they will receive CR(equal to 100%) for term 4 and term 4 will count for 10% of their final grade for that course for the year.
- If students do not receive credit for term 4, they will receive NC for that term and will receive 1.125 credits for a full year course, instead of the full 1.5 credits for a full year course
- If a student receives no credit (NC) for term 4, it will not negatively impact their GPA.
- If a student receives credit(CR) for term 4, it will positively impact their GPA.
- Teachers are making accommodations and modifications for those students who have a 504 Accommodation Plan and or an IEP. If your child is struggling with what is being assigned, please have them reach out to their teachers, guidance counselor and/or Special Education Liaisons to assist them. Even though we are working remotely, your child's team continues to consult regularly with each other to provide all learners access to their education.
- For each class, students can expect two assignments per week; each assignment should take students approximately 30 minutes.
- Teachers will use online remote learning teaching platforms of Google Classroom, Khan Academy and APEX.

AP Classes:

- All AP courses will be finished at the end of 3rd term
- All AP classes will be graded from terms 1-3
- AP classes will continue to review until the date of the exam, but will not be given any graded work after the end of term 3

Term 4 grade 12 Modification:

- Term 4 will run May 4, 2020-May 29, 2020
- We know that this pandemic has had the most impact on our seniors
- Seniors will not have any regular classes for Term 4, instead seniors are expected to complete a final project of their choice
- Completion of the senior final project will be noted on the student's transcript
- We will be calculating senior final grades using terms 1 3
- Seniors who have not completed their graduation requirements at the end of term 3 (4/29) will have an individualized graduation plan created for them by their guidance counselor
- Seniors will see a full description and requirements of the projects in the senior Google Classroom by Monday, May 4th.
